


How to Reset Your Password

Step 1:



Step 3:

Check your email and open the email from Zach Allen Golf with subject line: “Your membership password reset request.” If you don’t receive the email, please check that it didn’t get caught in your spam/junk folder.


Click the link inside of the email to reset your password.



Step 4:


The link in the email will bring you to the page where you can choose your new password.

Note: when you arrive at the page, the “new password” field will be filled with a suggested password. You do NOT need to use the suggested password, you can simply type in whatever you like... the only requirement is that it is at least 6 characters in length.
